- 7. **Protecting Yourself Legally:** What should and should not be in the contract, full scopes of work, lien waivers, and more.
- 8. **Greenwashing (Green Fraud):** Understanding the concept of "Green" (energy efficiency, ecofriendly, sustainability, etc.) in relation to home projects, and protecting yourself from dishonest contractors looking to cash in.
